

ROSSMOOR WOMEN'S 18 HOLE GOLF CLUB
GENERAL MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, July 24, 2014 1:30 p.m.
Dollar Clubhouse

CAPTAIN: Del Poirier opened the meeting by welcoming the new members, Kay Doyle, Nancy Park and Juna Lee. She announced that Pat Deisem is taking over from Cletia Bowron the chairing of the Championship Tournament.

TREASURER: Marcia Belcher made a budget report.

CO-CAPTAIN: Olivia Hsueh encouraged people to sign up for Open Day.

Guest Day: Robin Moreau said 60 people have signed up so far for Guest Day. She said if anyone wanted to participate only in the meals, they could pay \$23 for breakfast and lunch. Guest Day golfing participants will pay an additional \$5 for entrance into the tournament and \$24 for green fees.

Handicap/Rules: Pat Taylor asked everyone to post their scores when following the field on tournament days. She emphasized that people need to sign their scorecards correctly, with the marker signing the card as well as the players listed on the card. Pat was given a seated ovation for the great work she did on managing the 2-day Classic Tournament.

Team Play: Teddi Swanson made a brief report on Team Play. Janice Davis called in a request for volunteers to assist when Rossmoor hosts the Diablo League Team Play on August 14th. She needs spotters and chauffeurs and suggested that volunteers sign up for 2-hour windows of time.

WGANC Ambassador: Georgia Gordon stated we should not be allowing any more 5-hour rounds of golf. She reminded everyone to fill scorecards out alphabetically by LAST NAME.

Past Captain: Peggy Yamada announced that participants in the Charity Tournament on September 4th could play either 18 holes on Dollar Ranch or 9 holes on the Creekside course and that all four Rossmoor golf clubs would be participating. Proceeds will benefit hospice. Peggy said she has gotten \$4500 in sponsorship funds so far for the event.

Golf Advisory: Mary Hufford suggested that the 18ers charge less for the Invitational next year so the club doesn't end up with the excess funds. Marcia Belcher countered that all the bills for this year's Invitational aren't in yet so it's not possible to say what the true amount of excess funds is at this point.

Championship Tournament: Pat Deisem announced that the Championship Tournament would have prizes/recognition for three low gross players in the Championship flight and the other flights would have prizes/recognition for two low gross scores and one low net score.

New Business: Rene Snyder made the suggestion that ball washers be placed permanently at all the ladies' tees on the course, and not just at the men's tees.
