penalty

(2) Players must assess whether their final putt would have sunk into the hole, and then

use Most Likely Score, not to exceed Net Double Bogey.

(3) Players must still use Net Double Bogey as a maximum score or Most Likely Score if

they do not finish the hole, and Net Par for holes not played
