The Minutes of the February Meeting were approved (Fuller and Kutler)

Reports of Officers

PRESIDENT SNYDER

President Snyder called upon a report from the Technical Committee chaired by Greg Gould. Mr. Gould was investigating various options for modernizing and upgrading management systems. He primarily focused on the system used by the United States Golf Association (USGA). He reported that the cost of the system would be about \$2800.00/year if all golf associations in Rossmoor agreed to participate. Rich Fuller commented that the women's groups were not interested. Gould noted that a likely dues increase of about \$10.00/year/person would occur.

A lively discussion followed. Mr. Gould commented that adoption of a plan would make life easier for the Pro Shop. Mr. Kutler asked how changes could be made in the new system. Gould commented that few changes would be made to our current system. USGA assumes responsibility for storing all data.

Treasurer Ferrari asked about if the financial record would be closely monitored. Mr. Gould thought there would not be a problem in the financial area.

Mr. Iacullo and President Snyder raised concerns about the cost factor in relation to our current dues. Ed O'Dea commented that the system would be a godsend to Home and Away.

The Paso Tiempo course has been using the system for about a year. They commented that they "could not live without the system."

Mr. Ferrari asked if payments could be made by check or credit card.

John McDonnell currently heads the Saturday SNAFU system that has been using the system for a number of weeks. He described the use of the system and commented very favorably about it.

Mr. Gold commented that the system could track handicaps. Ed O'Dea asked if a handicap limitation could be set up. Mr. Gould responded affirmatively.

Ample discussion continued followed by a motion (Weiss/Snyder) to adopt the USGA model at an annual rate of \$2,800.00. The motion was unanimously approved.
