Reports of Officers

PRESIDENT GOULD

COMMUNICATIONS RING

MEMBERSHIP KEELEY

- Bill mentioned again the question about the cost of membership and whether or not the holein-one insurance cost should be an option (\$5) in membership fee; after some discussion it was decided we would have ONE fee for membership which includes the hole-in-one insurance cost.
- Bill reported that he has good response from Sponsors for the tournament and with the budget he has prepared we should be able to keep the cost at \$150/participant; there was discussion about how prize \$'s should be given for the Gross winners and the Net winners and it was decided they should be the same amounts.
