A question came up about playing from different tees.

Do 18ers win more playing from the red tees or combo tees on Thursday Play Days? We are about halfway through our season and here are the facts (Guest Day and the Invitational are excluded):

Number of players: 450

Number playing from the Ted Tees: 219 (49%) Number playing from the Combo Tees: 231 (51%)

Number of payouts: 152

Winners playing from the Red Tees: 74 (49%) Winners playing from the Combo Tees: 78 (51%)

Does it matter if I play from red or combo tees? Short answer: NO! because the GHIN system calculates and updates your Handicap Index on a daily basis. This is a complicated process but the end result is that your Handicap index allows you to

compete with any other player, regardless of their skill level, on a fair and equal basis on any course and at any tee.

Payouts are approximately one-third of the number of players for each Thursday Play Day (except the major tournaments). Payouts to-date:
