#### Other Items:

**2025 Budget walkthrough** will be held via Zoom on Monday July 15<sup>th</sup> at 9 am.

Request: Historically, for budget planning purposes we have assumed 100 members. In 2024, we have 124 members; in 2023, 130 members; in 2022, 107 members.

For 2025, should we stick with assuming 100 or change to 110 or 115?

**Standard payouts:** Laura & I are drafting recommendations for year-to-year standard payouts for 3 major tournaments.

## 4. EVENTS:

### **Classic Tournament Feedback**

Lana provided feedback on the classic event, mentioning good food and perfect weather. Although there was an overorder of food, the budget was met.

Positive feedback on the classic event.

### **Blue and White Tournament - Upcoming**

Discussion on the logistics of the Blue and White tournament (Donner), including the barbecuing hassle and food cost.

Suggestions were made to raise the price to \$20 per person and allocate \$5 as prize money for the winning team.

Quote from Stan for \$14.00 for a hotdog with salads and condiments.

Use the Donner room for the Blue and White tournament.

We agreed to change the format of Blue and White to charge \$20 per person and allocate \$5 as prize money for the winning team.

## **Handicap Tournament**

Discussion on the payout structure for the handicap tournament. Proposal to pay out more positions to make it more rewarding for participants. We should get this info out to our members to maybe get more people signed up.

## **Slush Fund Usage**

Discussion on the use of extra money from previous events and the restrictions on carrying over funds as per Mary Jean's instructions. Please Document the value of donated items like centerpieces for future reference

## 4. Rules – Joyce

Discussion on the need for a clear club policy regarding adherence to golf rules, 18ers Thursday play. Possible ideas: weekly or monthly rules emails. Joyce will continue offering the classes.

Marsha noted that the new rule (15 Hill) needs to be explained to the members. Joyce said she could make a diagram showing where to drop if you hit "onto" the hill.

## 5. Social Committee (Lana):

Roles discussion on what/how the social committee should be involved in event planning. Time constraints make it impossible for the committee to be at every event meeting.

## 6. Membership (Teddi):

1 new member just signed up. She wants to play in Follow the Field this week. It will need to be entered by hand, but it is doable. The 2025 budget board suggests a 110-member number.

### 7. EBTP (Karla/Pat):

We are five matches into the season. Teams are doing well. Regarding the DVTP discussion, Karla is to email EBTP members to gauge their interest. Email needs to include the 2025 estimated costs.

## 8. Handicap (Daisy):

Daisy had to remind members how to score whiffs. Keeping accurate scores and compliance with NCGA rules.

### 9. Past Captain (Margo):

More water is needed on course, and marshals need to carry extra when available. We need to confirm the Summer Splash Event chairs. The event is on August 22, and we need to have a kick-off meeting.

# **Technical Committee Report Out:** Laura Kim / MJ Kidd

- \* The Board agreed to reinstate Follow-the-Field for the major tournaments. This has been changed in the Policy & Procedures and updated on the website.
- \* The Resolving Rules Issues has been added to the Policy & Procedures document under the C. Rules section and updated on the website.
  - 1. Resolving Rules Issues: If rules issues arise during play that cannot be resolved by players, their request for a ruling should be follow this procedure:
    - a. Players should bring the rules issue to the 18ers Pro Shop liaison as soon as possible.

- b. If the ruling is straightforward, the 18ers Pro Shop liaison will make the ruling and then notify the 18er Rules Chair about the incident. The Rules Chair will inform the Tournament Chair and the Handicap Chair.
- c. If the ruling is not straightforward, the 18ers Pro Shop liaison will notify the 18er Rules Chair and the ruling will be made by the Tournament Committee, comprised of the Handicap Chair, Thursday Sweeps Chair, Rules Chair, and 18ers Pro Shop liaison.

## Handicap Report: Daisy Soo Hoo

Handicap. 31 members signed up for the Handicap Tournament. All 31 members meet the 5 round requirement. 19 members signed up for June 13 and 16 for June 20 follow the field.

## Rules Report - Joyce McCann

At some point I think the Board needs to state what the 18ers policy is regarding expectations re 18er's knowledge of the basic Rules of Golf. 2024 is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year we have offered On-Course Rules Classes. Over these 2 ½ years, 48 players have taken at least 1 class. That is significantly less than half of our membership. Teddi has kindly encouraged new members to take the classes, but few have. I believe the 9ers require (or at least used to) that new members take the basic course they offer, but we do not. My feeling is not that we have to require that members take these courses, but I do think we need to put in writing what our position is.

### East Bay Team Play (EBTP) Report - Karla Witte + Pat McSween

The first 5 matches are complete. We are 11th place for Gross and 12th for Net. Claudia beat me to the punch by talking about the possibility of joining Moraga for Diablo Team play. We do not need to make a decision at the meeting, but we wanted the board to know the offer was made.

There's been some tentative conversations about whether there is enough interest among our membership to consider rejoining the Diablo Team Play league as a co-team with Moraga who is currently having trouble getting four players from Orinda each time there's a match (Orinda is Moraga's current co-team in DTP league - they call themselves Morinda). Not sure we have enough interest or if we're already tapped out with EBTP.

I wish I could be there to join the discussion. I always enjoyed playing in Diablo but it is a lower-handicap affair and we may not have enough players still to field two teams without burning everyone out. And Mormoor would be a really weird name;)
